Real Learning for Real Life

Hello, Red Lion Family!

We are looking forward to the community gathering to support the many Lion Athletic Events occurring this school year! While we anticipate exciting environments, thrilling plays, and competitive rivalry, it is also important to understand spectator expectations at events. Here at Red Lion, we take pride in the way our community conducts itself and we hold the ZOO CREW and our spectators in high esteem.

While attending Red Lion events, safety is our number one priority. It is our duty to provide a safe environment for all spectators, fans, and student athletes. We ask that the community please adhere to District procedures in order to help us ensure a safe event. In the event of an emergency, please contact an event staff member, usually wearing yellow, who will address your needs.

At athletic events, sportsmanship is an expectation. Please remember that coaches, officials, and student athletes all give their best efforts in the spirit of competition. Your admission allows you to enjoy the exhibition of skills developed by student athletes in an educational setting. We ask that you give our student athletes positive encouragement and support. Booing, taunting, or intimidating coaches, officials, or players is unsportsmanlike and unacceptable. This behavior could result in removal from the facility. We ask that spectators police themselves and hold others accountable at events.

We have new admittance and game-day procedures for at Horn Field. For our Friday night football games, all students in grades K-8 must be accompanied by an adult who is responsible for supervising them for the entirety of the event. In addition, there will be no re-admittance for any student during the game, meaning if they leave the premises, they will not be allowed to return.

When attending events at Red Lion, the following admittance procedures for Friday night football games apply:

- All elementary and junior high school students (grades K-8) must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at all times.
 - Unaccompanied elementary and junior high school students will not be permitted to enter the stadium.
- Only clear bags will be permitted in Horn Field:
 - One of the following three options are permitted in Horn Field.
 - 12" x 6" x 12" clear tote bag
 - 11" x 11" x 0" resealable one-gallon plastic bag (no bigger than 12" x 6" x 12")
 - 4" x 6" x 1" small clutch or wristlet
 - Diaper bags, strollers, walkers, and other medically necessary items will be permitted following a detailed search.

- There will be no re-entry allowed for students and limited re-entry for adults.
 - After half-time all re-entry will take place only at the main gate on Horace Mann Ave and at the walking gate at the press box entrance.
- Spectators must keep moving along the pathway around Horn Field. There will be no loitering or gathering in groups.
- Spectators will only be permitted to stand along the Horn Field fence in designated areas.
 - There will be no standing along the pathway from the concession stand to the home side bleachers or in front of the cheerleaders. Please see the map below for detailed information.
- Tobacco products, vaping, illegal substances, and alcohol are strictly prohibited on District grounds. Citations will be issued when necessary.
- The Red Lion Area School District Athletic Department reserves the right to prohibit students demonstrating chronic inappropriate behaviors and truancy from attending any future events.
- YAIAA, District III, PIAA, and RLASD Rules and Regulations will be followed.
- Ticket prices are \$5 for adults and \$3 for students and senior citizens.

As a reminder, sporting events are school functions, and student behavioral expectations are the same as when they are in school. Those joining us at Horn Field are there to support all participants and enjoy the game.

I encourage the Red Lion Family to join us this school year as our student athletes embark on another exciting journey in their careers. Red Lion's student athletes will continue to be successful on the athletic fields/courts and in the classroom - they dedicate countless hours to their program and show up every day with grit and determination! We look forward to sharing their journeys with you and thank you for your support of RLASD athletic programs.
